



ow to Load Like a Pro

- Pre-mark all of your boxes. This will ensure that they end up in the right rooms.
- Make a floor plan of your new residence. It helps speed the unloading if the mover knows exactly where to place the furniture.
- Load boxes first and furniture last. This way a path will be clear when you load (and unload) your furniture.
- The key to a successful move is careful planning. These general tips, along with our packing tips, will help ensure that your move goes smoothly.
 - Request "Perfect Payment Record" letters from your utility companies in order to avoid paying hundreds of dollars in deposits at your new home.
 - Keep your receipts. Many moving expenses may be tax-deductible. To find out which ones are, consult a tax advisor or call the Internal Revenue Service. Ask for Publication 521: "Tax Information on Moving Expenses.
 - Call ahead and order telephone directories for your new home so they'll be waiting for you. And remember, take along your old phone book. It will come in handy after the move.
 - If you're moving during the school year, you may have to pre-enroll children in their new schools before you actually move. Check with school officials to get their advice.
 - If you're going to need a babysitter on moving day, reserve one beforehand.
 - If you have pets, talk to your veterinarian about what you can do to make the move easier on them.
